Victoria United Church



The Methodist Church, named in honour of Queen Victoria was built in “Jubilee” year. This designated heritage site is one of three churches from the 1890’s still standing in the downtown area

Northern Bank



The distinctive “Northern Bank” design can be found in other places across the prairies. It became a Royal Bank in 1919 and in 1968 served as the R.M. of Arthur office.

Melita Cemetery Vault



This 2-storey Chapel/Vault is set into a hillside for access to the bottom floor.
