There are a number of fine heritage homes. The Argue House was built in 1905 by James Argue who settled in 1881 and later served as an MLA.

Plaques commemorating schools, the Elgin Village Centennial, and St. John's Anglican Church are displayed on the Main Street.



The Elgin War Memorial was erected in 1922.
